The Local Chapter Liaison volunteer will manage LFBS' university chapters through onboarding, training, monitoring project performance, tracking progress, providing administrative support, and supporting the planning and execution of fundraising and outreach activities that further the goals of LFBS' mission.

Responsibilities

- Create, develop and maintain project proposals, project management plans and documents
- Coordinate resources to ensure projects stay within scope, schedule, and budget
- Maintain & monitor all project correspondence internally and externally, ensuring communication expectations are met and upheld
- Review project marketing and supplementary materials in accordance with established guidelines
- Hold periodic meetings with project members and LFBS members to ensure goals and deliverables are in agreement and on track
- Provide additional administrative assistance as needed to support the LFBS team

Requirements

- Applicants must have reliable access to wifi and smartphone for writing and posting
- A diploma or degree, or working toward a diploma or degree, is ideal but not required
- Strong interpersonal, writing, and communications skills in English
- Exceptional writing and editing skills
- Resourcefulness, innovation and adaptability
- Knowledge and understanding of development issues in the global south, antioppressive practice, and human rights
